- 1) His tip Dim A\$(49,8) allocates space for 50 instances of the string A\$ which is 8 characters long. When A\$ is referenced in programs like A\$(n) as in other dialects of basic, it doesn't work, you will get ILLEGAL VARIABLE message. You must reference it as A\$(N,0). Mr. Ferguson states this is not referenced in any APF documentation he has seen.
- 2) Q Shouldn't I be able to place several IF THENS on the same line?
 - A No, because the first time it finds the condition untrue the program continues on to the next line. This cannot be done on other computers either.
- 3) Tip The following manual is available from the of the IM-1 chip "6800 PROGRAMMING REFERENCE MANUAL" M68PRM(D) Send \$3.00 to Motorola Semi-Conductor products, Box 20912, Phoenix, AZ 85036

Documentation for using peripherals with the IM-1 does come with the peripheral, such as the Disk Drive, RS232 port, Angle to the case of a printer, the information available with the RS232 as well as information standard to the computer is needed. There is no one book on a printer with the IM-1 since everyone uses different printers. need to change pin configuration on the printer.
