FROM G. TAYLOR OF MUSCLE SHOALS, ALABAMA

Radio Shack book #62-2015, "Computer Programming in Basic for Everyone" has programs that, with minor changes, will load into the IM-1.

FROM and TO DAN FERGUSON OF LORTON, VA

1) His tip - Dim A\$(49,8) allocates space for 50 instances of the string A\$ which is 8 characters long. When A\$ is referenced in programs like A\$(n) as in other dialects of basic, it doesn't work, you will get ILLEGAL VARIABLE message. You must reference it as A\$(N,0). Mr. Ferguson states this is not referenced in any APF documentation he has seen.

2) Q - Shouldn't I be able to place several IF THENS on the same line?

A - No, because the first time it finds the condition untrue the program continues on to the next line. This cannot be done on other computers either.

3) Tip - The following manual is available from the of the IM-1 chip - "6800 PROGRAMMING REFERENCE MANUAL" M68PRM(D) Send \$3.00 to Motorola Semi-Conductor products, Box 20912, Phoenix, AZ 85036

- 4) Documentation for using peripherals with the IM-1 does come with the peripheral, such as the Disk Drive, RS232 port, etc. In the case of a printer, the information available with the RS232 as well as information standard to the computer is needed. There is no one book on a printer with the IM-1 since everyone uses different printers. You may need to change pin configuration on the printer. We will publish a short section on hardware/software required in the next newsletter.

- 1) Q - Is there anyway to force the machine to start a sequence (of random numbers) at a different spot each running?
A - Yes, your line was almost correct, all we did was move your 36 as follows:

A - No, not in letter size, you can go in a draw them in the graphics mode, however, they will be a little larger.

A - We do not believe you can, not only do you require the building block but also the RS232 to connect a printer. The port in the computer is not compatible with this.
